



**A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF
THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO ENACT
CODES FOR CIVIL PROCEDURES OF THE
TRIBAL COURT**

RESOLUTION 2014- 13

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council (hereafter referred to as Council) is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians (hereafter referred to as Constitution) to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, The Council is authorized by Article XII of the Constitution to provide for a procedure which shall insure that any litigant receives due process of law together with prompt and speedy relief, and

WHEREAS, the Council rescinds the enactment of Title 13- Civil Procedure- of Delaware Tribal Statutes dated October 18, 1984 and any Civil Procedure Codes enacted to this date and declares a need to enact updated codes to meet the judicial needs of the tribal government, and

WHEREAS, the Council adopts this resolution to authorize codes for the Civil Procedure of the Delaware Tribal Court that will provide guidance, direction, and procedures for the operation of the court in all civil judicial matters, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Council hereby enacts Title 13 Civil Procedure Codes of 2014, and directs that said codes be incorporated in the laws of the Delaware Tribe.
