

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE
DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS AUTHORIZING THE
SUBMISSION OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE
COORDINATED TRIBAL ASSISTANCE SOLICITATION
FY 2014 COMPETITIVE GRANT**

RESOLUTION 2014-14

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council adopts this resolution authorizing the submission of an application to the U.S. Department of Justice for competitive grant under the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation for the revitalization of the Court; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council recognizes the need to develop a Tribal program in alcohol and substance abuse to allow the Tribe to engage in planning efforts to address the needs of the Tribe's justice system and to comprehensively address alcohol and substance abuse-related crime; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council was presented the proposal for a administrative review and comment at a special Tribal Council meeting March 20, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians has determined that it is in the best interest of the tribal community and hereby approves the submission of the U.S. Department of Justice Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation FY 2014 Competitive Grant; and

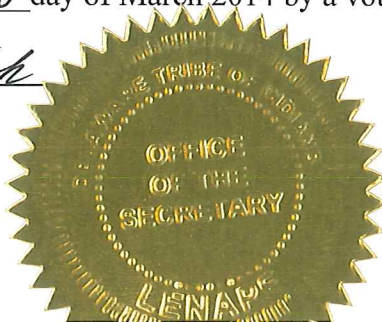
WHEREAS, if funded, the Delaware Tribe will receive an estimated \$75,000 in funds for an eighteen(18) month project for the Court to include provisions for space, training, code review and strategic planning and up to \$750,000 for a three (3) year project with focus on alcohol and substance abuse crime.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Delaware Tribal Council supports the submission of an application and request for funding from the U.S. Department of Justice Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation for the FY 2014 Competitive Grant.
