



A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO APPROVE THE AMENDMENT OF THE TRIBAL/HOUSING BY APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF 1004 WALNUT, CLAREMORE, OK FROM A STARTER HOME TO LOW RENT FAMILY HOME

RESOLUTION 2014-17

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians (approved by Bureau of Indian Affairs, May 26, 2009) to represent the Delaware Tribe and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the tribe and the Delaware Tribe Housing Program (DTHP); and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council adopts this resolution authorizing the approval of transfer of 1004 Walnut Street, Claremore, OK from its current status as a Starter home to a Low Rent Family Unit;

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council has created the Delaware Tribe Housing Program to improve and advance the housing status of Delaware tribal members and future generations; and


