



**A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL
OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS
TO DISMISS PENDING CRIMINAL
CHARGES AGAINST A FORMER
EMPLOYEE**

RESOLUTION 2014-47

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, Article V of the Delaware Tribe of Indians Constitution and Bylaws grants the Delaware Tribal Council the power to establish rules to regulate its own proceedings; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council recognizes the importance of communication of the Tribal Council is in the best interest of the Delaware Tribe of Indians; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Delaware Tribal Council does hereby resolve to dismiss all criminal charges brought against Thomas Alsup by the Delaware Tribe of Indians.
