



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOYS & GIRLS CLUB TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MENTORING PROGRAM FOR AT RISK TRIBAL YOUTH AND TO ACCEPT FUNDING ON BEHALF OF THE COMMUNITY FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS TO SUPPORT THE MENTORING PROGRAM FOR AT RISK TRIBAL YOUTH.

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe of Indians Tribal Council is the governing body of the Delaware Tribe of Indians Indian Community (the "Community"); and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is empowered, under the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians Indian Community to promote and protect the health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Community and its members; and

WHEREAS, the safety and well-being of the Community, and its members, is a high priority to the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs (the "OJP") announced the MENTORING PROGRAM FOR AT RISK TRIBAL YOUTH to establish a program based on one- on-one or group mentoring with at risk youth, and

WHEREAS, In 2008, the Boys and Girls Club of Chelsea was selected as one (1) of the mentoring sites in Indian Country to participate in the MENTORING PROGRAM FOR AT RISK TRIBAL YOUTH; and

WHEREAS, the Boys and Girls Club of Chelsea will work with the OJP to establish the mentoring program; and

WHEREAS, the OJP will provide the Boys and Girls Club of Chelsea with funding to assist in the development and implementation of the MENTORING PROGRAM FOR AT RISK TRIBAL YOUTH plans, including funding for training and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Community for the Boys and Girls Club of Chelsea to participate in the MENTORING PROGRAM FOR AT RISK TRIBAL YOUTH.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Delaware Tribe of Indians Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Boys and Girls Club of Chelsea to participate in the MENTORING PROGRAM FOR AT RISK TRIBAL YOUTH PROGRAM and accept any funds on behalf of the Community to support the MENTORING PROGRAM FOR AT RISK TRIBAL YOUTH PROGRAM.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Chief, or designee, is hereby authorized to sign any other documents or take any other necessary action to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

CERTIFICATION

Pursuant to authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians, the foregoing Resolution was adopted on February 21, 2017 at a meeting held at the Delaware Tribe of Indians Tribal Complex at which a quorum of members were present, by a vote of 7 For; — Oppose; — Abstain; — Absent.
