DTHP is applying for ICDBG-CARES funding

Project Description Summary:

Description of Activities and Prevention, Preparation and/or Response to COVID-19.

The Delaware Tribe of Indians (DTI) proposes to undertake several activities to assist the local community in addressing problems associated with the COVID-19 pandemic.

- 1). Activity Description – Rehabilitation of 122 existing affordable housing units to include replacement of existing and installation of new HVAC systems to improve ventilation and air quality in the residential living environment which will reduce the risk of additional COVID-19 cases and community spread.
- 2.) Activity Description – Rehabilitation of one existing DTI owned housing unit to make it a potential quarantine/shelter-in-place unit to temporarily house persons who are in need of quarantine due to COVID-19.
- 3). Activity Description – Contract for security personnel to patrol the local communities and neighborhoods to assist with enforcement of social distancing requirements and other public health requirements adopted by local, state, tribal or federal governments.
- 4). Activity Description - Rehabilitation of the entrance and foyer of the DTI's office building and community facility which will ensure that only healthy persons are allowed to enter the building and reduce the risk of community spread of COVID-19 particularly in the elderly population which is one of the most vulnerable demographic groups.
- 5). Activity Description - Purchase of specialized cleaning supplies and equipment to safely and thoroughly sanitize housing units prior to new occupancy.
- 6). Activity Description - Acquisition of up to two modular homes to be utilized for shelter-in-place or quarantine units for homeless families, low-income households and/or other vulnerable population groups.

Final Report and Closeout: The DTI anticipates that the grant will be completed and closed out by August 31, 2021.
