This is to acknowledge the receipt of the Final Project Report for your FY 2003 Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act [NAGPRA] grant with the National Park Service (Grant Number **40-03-GP-55R**). The report dated July 1, 2003, was received in our office on July 9, 2003. We appreciate receiving the report and being informed of the accomplishments achieved with this grant assistance.

The final Work-Cost Budget breakdown included with the report summarizes the actual costs charged to the grant broken out by budget categories. The approved budget is hereby revised by increasing the amount for Travel by \$170 from \$14,256 to \$14,426 and decreasing the amount for Other Costs (burial container) by \$170 from \$170 to \$0.

The final payment request dated July 1, 2003, for a total of **\$14,426** has been approved, and Sandra Crawford, Business Manager, has been notified that the funds may be drawn down using Smartlink. This grant is now closed, and there are no remaining funds available for this project.
