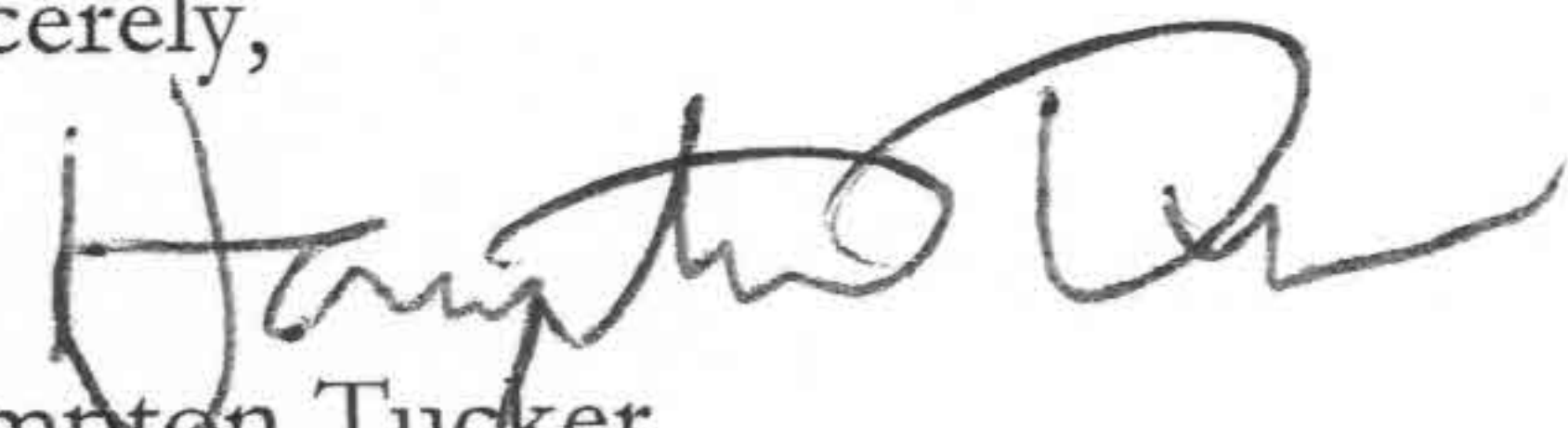

Please note the following pertinent information regarding **Grant Number 40-10-GP-R16**

- ❖ Your NAGPRA Grant Number is **40-10-GP-R16**. Please refer to this grant number in all correspondence, phone calls and e-mails.
- ❖ **Grant Number 40-10-GP-R16** has been awarded \$5,000, however, the National Park Service withholds 15% of the award until the end of the grant period. In order to receive the withheld amount (\$750) you must submit the Final Project Report and the final request for reimbursement. In other words, you will have \$4,250 of expendable funds available for all grant related work once your SMARTLINK account is processed. Please plan accordingly.
- ❖ Please make certain to mark your calendar for your first Interim Report and SF-425 due date (the SF-425 replaced the SF-269A and SF-272). The Interim Report and SF-425 are due **September 30, 2010** and every six months thereafter.
