













# Lenape Names of Birds and More

These are names, photos, and songs of some of the common birds known to the Lenape or Delaware Indians. In the first column there are links that can be clicked to take you to the Lenape Talking Dictionary ([www.talk-lenape.org](http://www.talk-lenape.org)). Place the cursor over the second link in Italics link and click to take you to the dictionary where you can hear the song. In some cases hold down the CONTROL (CTRL) key while clicking on the link. When you are in the Dictionary click on the speaker icon to play the song then close the Dictionary to return to this list.
