I am pleased to inform you that the Delaware Tribe of Indians is willing to accept fee simple title to the housing lot that contains the gravesite of Chief Neconhecon. We also wish to express our gratitude for your considerable financial commitment to provide for the transfer filing expenses, legal expenses, site preparation, monumentation and long term maintenance of the site. We sincerely appreciate your good faith efforts in helping us protect and preserve this important site.

Once we accept title to the property we will enter into an agreement with the Wyandotte County Historical Society, who will oversee the long-term preservation of Chief Neconhecon's grave.
