

A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE INSTITUTE OF MUSEUM AND LIBRARY SERVICES NATIVE AMERICAN LIBRARY SERVICES: ENHANCEMENT GRANT FY 2013.

RESOLUTION 2013 - 15

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council adopts this resolution authorizing the submission of an application to the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) Native American Library Services: Enhancement Grant for the enhancement of library services offered by the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council also recognizes the need for an enhanced library for the benefit of Tribal members; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians has determined that it is in the best interest of the tribal community and hereby approves the submission of the Native American Library Services: Enhancement Grant offered by IMLS; and

WHEREAS, if funded, the Delaware Tribe will receive an estimated \$150,000 in funds for a project for the enhancement of the tribal library.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Delaware Tribal Council supports the submission of an application and request for funding from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) Native American Library Services: Enhancement Grant.
