



A RESOLUTION OF THE DELAWARE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO APPROVE THE RELOCATION, TRAVEL, AND SUBSTANCE-ABUSE PREVENTION POLICIES OF THE TRIBAL HOUSING PROGRAM

RESOLUTION 2014-09

WHEREAS, The Delaware Tribal Council is authorized in Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent the Delaware Tribe and act in all manners that concern the general welfare of the tribe, and,

WHEREAS, The Delaware Tribal Council authorizes the Housing Program to operate with policies that provide guidance, direction, and procedures for housing activities and housing management, and,

WHEREAS, the Relocation Policy is necessary to relocate targeted housing residents while addressing rehabilitation needs found throughout the Housing Program stock located in the tribe's housing program jurisdiction, and,

WHEREAS, the Travel Policy is necessary to identify rules for staff and Tribal Council members to travel on official business on behalf of the Housing Program of the Delaware Tribe, including forms of travel conveyance and payment for travel expenses, and,

WHEREAS, the Substance-Abuse Prevention Policy is necessary to protect the safety, health, and well-being of Housing Program employees, its clients, and all people who come into contact with its workplaces and properties, and is in keeping with tribal personnel policies regarding substance-abuse prevention and providing a drug-free workplace environment,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Delaware Tribal Council does hereby approve this resolution authorizing the Relocation, Travel, and Substance-Abuse Prevention Policies for the Delaware Tribe Housing Program.
