

## A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO DISMISS THE PENDING COMPLAINT AGAINST COUNCILOR NATHAN YOUNG

## **RESOLUTION 2014-48**

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

**WHEREAS**, Article V of the Delaware Tribe of Indians Constitution and Bylaws grants the Delaware Tribal Council the power to establish rules to regulate its own proceedings; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Delaware Tribal Council recognizes the importance of communication of the Tribal Council is in the best interest of the Delaware Tribe of Indians; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council agrees sometimes a situation arises where the current policy does not meet immediate needs of the Tribe; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the Delaware Tribal Council does hereby resolve to immediately dismiss the complaint filed against Councilor Nathan Young by tribal member, Dee Ketchum.
