## **RESOLUTION 2018-17**

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, to conduct business and provide as much safety as possible for our employees, tribal members, visitors, guests and elected officials, a policy shall be immediately implemented to afford safety to all of the aforementioned individuals.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby reserve the right to require the Tribal Operations Manager to notify, by certified mail, any non-tribal person of banishment following an illegal act, whether prosecuted or not. The Tribal Council must agree by majority vote of the banishment which will be from any and all properties owned by the Delaware Tribe of Indians. These notifications may also be filed with the local law enforcement (city and county) to provide for trespass charges to be filed if the notified individual fails to adhere to the request.
