WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is empowered by Article V of the Constitution of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to cultivate, promote and encourage the culture and crafts of the LENNI LENAPE, and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council seeks to obtain funding from the National Parks Service (NPS) under the Tribal Heritage Grant Program FY2019 Opportunity Number P19AS00200 in the amount of \$47,269.00, for a project titled Documenting and Teaching Cultural Traditions; Indexing and Cataloguing Archival Materials, and,


