WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized in Article V of the Delaware Constitution to cultivate, promote and encourage the culture and crafts of the LENNI LENAPE, and,

WHEREAS, the Lenape Language Program has utilized funding from the National Science Foundation in previous years to preserve and revitalize the Lenape language, and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council wants to continue preservation efforts that will expand the current vocabulary and create greater accessibility to online data and lessons for the Lenape Talking Dictionary,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby authorize and approve the submission of a grant application to the National Science Foundation for the Lenape Language Program.
