WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe Cultural Resources Department seeks to obtain an Indigenous Community Research Fellowship Award from the American Philosophical Society to research, study, and examine materials at the APS Library & Museum in Philadelphia,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby authorize and approve the submission of an application to The American Philosophical Society for a 2019 Indigenous Community Research Fellowship.
