WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is empowered by Article V of the Constitution of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to cultivate, promote and encourage the culture and crafts of the LENNAPE, and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council seeks to obtain funding from the Oklahoma Historical Society (OHS) under the Heritage Preservation Grant Program FY2020 in the amount of \$9,000.00, for a project titled *Develop Strategic Plan For Delaware Tribe Cultural Center*, and,

WHEREAS, the grant budget requires that the Tribe provide a ten percent (10%) cash match thus will appropriate \$900.00 from the General Operating Fund upon the award of the grant, and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is committed to this proposed project by directing the Cultural Resources Department to perform all activities in the project for the benefit of the Delaware Tribe and its members,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby approve this resolution and authorizes it be submitted with the grant application to the Oklahoma Historical Society.
