

A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WCCCF TO DELIVER CHILD CARE SERVICES THROUGH CCDF

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians adopts this resolution to:

 Enter into an MOA with the Washington County Child Care Foundation to deliver child care services under CCDF regulations at 45 CFR Parts 98 and 99, "Child Care and Development Fund," Final Rule, published September 30, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe of Indians is eligible to apply for such funding thru the direct Federal relationship with the federal government and listing in the Federal Register of recognized tribal entities; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council has discussed the MOA; and at the Delaware Tribe of Indians Tribal Council on June 20, 2020,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians has determined that it is in the best interest of the tribal community and hereby approves the MOA with the WCCCF; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby authorize and approve the MOA with the WCCCF to deliver child care services under CCDF regulations at 45 CFR Parts 98 and 99, "Child Care and Development Fund," Final Rule, published on September 30, 2016. This resolution expires on September 30, 2020.
