WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2013, the Delaware Tribal Council enacted Resolution No. 2013-56 amending the Delaware Tribe of Indians Insurance Company Act; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe of Indians has determined it is in the best interest of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to Amend the Delaware Tribe of Indians Insurance Company Act.

WHEREAS, Part 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS, amending the definition of risk to expand the scope of business that can be insurer/reinsured to meet the needs for growth of the domicile.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians declares, that the Delaware Tribe of Indians Insurance Company Act is amended as attached hereto.
