

A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO AUTHORIZE CIVICUS GROUP, LLC TO SUBMIT THE STATE SMALL BUSINESS CREDIT INIATIVE (SBCI) SUBMISSION

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, President Biden signed The American Rescue Plan Act, which provided \$10 billion to fund the State Small Business Credit Initiative (SSBCI). SSBCI will fund state, territory, and Tribal government small business credit support and investment programs; and,

WHEREAS, the ARPA allocated \$500 million for Tribal government programs through the State Small Business Credit Initiative (SSBCI); and,

WHEREAS, individual Tribes are expected to receive minimum allocations of at least \$400,000; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe of Indians desires to file a Notice of Intent to participate in the program to support current and future tribal owned small business; and,

WHEREAS, the SSBCI program submissions by authorized by tribal resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Delaware Tribal Council authorizes Civicus Group, LLC to submit a Notice of Intent on behalf of the Delaware Tribe of Indians on or before the deadline of August 16, 2021 and to submit a full application on or before the deadline of December 11, 2021.
