A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS TO ADMINISTER THE POTABLE WATER FUNDING

RESOLUTION 2023-67

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution and By-Laws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians, the Tribe's governing body is the Delaware Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to enter into a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to administer the Potable Water funding as made available pursuant to H.R. 1319, Public Law 117-2, American Rescue Plan Act of 2021; and

WHEREAS, the potable water funding is a one-time, non-recuring funding in the amount of \$70,127.12 (seventy thousand one hundred twenty-seven dollars and twelve cents); and

WHEREAS, the potable water funding is available until expended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby authorize and approve to enter into a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to administer the potable water funding, as provided under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, in association with and according to the approved scope of work, budget and budget justification.
