

A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO UTILIZE ARPA FUNDS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SECURITY CAMERAS IN ALL DELAWARE HOUSING DEPARTMENT NEIGHBORHOODS

RESOLUTION 2024-32

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution and By-Laws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians, the Tribe's governing body is the Delaware Tribal Council and under Article V has the authority "to manage and control community tribal property, enterprises, and other economic projects and programs of the Delaware Tribe"; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe was allocated funding from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds from the U.S. Department of the Treasury established under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA); and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe holds their duty to revitalize public spaces by ensuring safety and security as central to the vision of a prosperous future for membership; and

WHEREAS, adopts this resolution to approve the purchase of security cameras to promote the health and safety of Delaware Tribal members in and near the Delaware Housing Department Neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the purchase and budget will be allocated as follows: American Rescue Plan Act- State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund in the amount of \$52,290 for the total purchase price and investment in security cameras for Delaware Housing Department neighborhoods; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby authorize and approve the Installation of Security Cameras in All Delaware Housing Department Neighborhoods.
