

A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO PURCHASE 3 VEHICLES FOR CHILDCARE PROGRAMMING

RESOLUTION 2024-77

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution and By-Laws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians, the Tribe's governing body is the Delaware Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe expresses a need to purchase a 3 vehicles to carryout Childcare, Tribal and Early Head Start program goals such as providing transportation to children to and from the LELC when needed within the service area; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe expresses a need to provide subsidized childcare service to families across the Bartlesville and surrounding areas and staff will need to drive to the provider locations and conduct routine visits; and

WHEREAS, the Childcare Director and other additional supportive administration staff will need to provide ongoing monitoring, training, nutritional support and services on a regular weekly basis; and

WHEREAS, the Childcare Department has taken possession of the Chealsea Childcare building and ongoing maintenance is needed. A vehicle can support the ongoing service needs of the LELC and the Chelsea site on a regular basis as needed; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the 3 vehicles is not to exceed \$160,000 and will be paid from fund 680.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby authorize and approve to purchase 3 vehicles to carryout Childcare, Tribal and Early Head Start programming.
