## **RESOLUTION 2024-78**

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution and By-Laws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians, the Tribe's governing body is the Delaware Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, all appropriations of the Delaware tribal funds made by this resolution are for one (1) year appropriations for fiscal year 2024, to begin October 1, 2023 and end September 30, 2024, subject to the fiscal year limitations set forth in this resolution, unless otherwise stated; and

WHEREAS, Family and Children Services has modified the current approved budget to reflect the addition of line items for legal assistance to assist domestic violence clients, new IT equipment in supplies, furniture, and moving costs; and

WHEREAS, Family and Children Services has modified the existing budget to add additional line items, resulting in a change of more than 10% of the award amount in line items for legal assistance and IT equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians adopts this resolution; to express the desire of the Tribe to approve the attached fiscal year 2024 budget modification #2.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** The Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby authorize and approve the FY24 Family and Children Services, Family Violence Prevention and Services Act FUND 23VP budget modification #2.
