



**A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL
OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO
SUBMIT A FEE-TO-TRUST APPLICATION TO
THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR
AND TO REQUEST CERTAIN LAND IN
CANEY, KANSAS TO BE TAKEN INTO TRUST
FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE DELAWARE
TRIBE OF INDIANS**

RESOLUTION 2025-02

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians (the “Tribe”) to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribe owns certain real property held in fee status located in the City of Caney, Kansas, County of Montgomery, which is contiguous to existing land held by the United States in trust for the benefit of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to transfer the deed to the fee property to the United States, Department of the Interior, by and through the Bureau of Indian Affairs, for the purpose of placing the land into trust status; and,

WHEREAS, the land to be placed in trust will be used for additional Tribal governmental offices and will be contiguous to existing trust land where the Tribe’s family services department, domicile business, and the Delaware Tribal Court are located; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Chief to submit a fee-to-trust application with the appropriate officials at the Bureau of Indian Affairs and to take all necessary steps to effectuate a transfer of the deed to the fee property to the United States for the land to be taken into trust for the benefit of the Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DELAWARE TRIBAL COUNCIL, that the Delaware Tribe of Indians authorizes the transfer of the deed for the following real property in Caney, Kansas, the legal description of the parcel being:

The N/2 of the SW/4 of the NE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 13, Township 35 South, Range 13 East of the 6th P.M., Montgomery County, Kansas AND the West 419 feet of the South 50 feet of the NE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 13, Township 35 South, Range 13 East of the 6th P.M., LESS AND EXCEPT a tract commencing at the Southeast corner of said NE/4 of the NE/4; thence on an assumed bearing of South 88°55’52” West, 218.42 feet along the South line of said NE/4 of the NE/4 to the

Southeast corner of said tract to the point of beginning; FIRST COURSE, thence continuing South 88°55'52" West, 92.86 feet along the South line of said Tract of land; SECOND COURSE, thence North 03°38'49" West, 34.95 feet; THIRD COURSE, thence North 08°44'30" East, 15.31 feet to the North line of said tract of land; FOURTH COURSE, thence North 88°55'52" East, 91.10 feet along said North line to the Northeast corner of said tract of land; FIFTH COURSE, thence South 01°53'27" East, 50.01 feet along the East line of said tract of land to the point of beginning, Montgomery County, Kansas


A tract of land located in a portion of the S/2 of the SW/4 of the NE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 13, Township 35 South, Range 13 East of the 6th P.M., City of Caney, Montgomery County, Kansas; more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the East Quarter Corner of Section 13; thence N 89°37'03" W, along the South line of the SE/4 of the NE/4, a distance of 1,297.83 feet to the Southwest corner thereof; thence N 00°38'28" W, along the West line of the SE/4 of the NE/4, a distance of 1,333.20 feet to the Northwest corner thereof; thence S 89°06'35" E, along the South line of the NE/4 of the NW/4, a distance of 441.10 feet for the true point of beginning; thence 01°07'05" E a distance of 328.58 feet to the North line of the S/2 of the SW/4 of the NE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 13; thence S 89°11'40" E, along said North line, a distance of 203.50 feet to the Northeast corner thereof; thence S 00°22'38" E, along the East line of the S/2 of the SW/4 of the NE/4 of the NE/4 a distance of 328.96 feet to the Southeast corner thereof; thence N 89°06'36" W along the South line of the NE/4 of the NE/4, a distance of 212.09 feet to the point of beginning

to the United States of America, Department of the Interior, by and through the Bureau of Indian Affairs, for the purpose of placing said parcel into trust status.
