



## A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO DELEGATE REPRESENTATION AT THE INTERTRIBAL BUFFALO COUNCIL

### RESOLUTION 2026-11

**WHEREAS**, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Constitution and By-Laws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians, the Tribe's governing body is the Delaware Tribal Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Delaware Tribe of Indians is an unincorporated Tribe of Indians, having accepted the provisions of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984); and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribe, in order to establish its tribal organization; to conserve its tribal property; to develop its common resources; and to promote the general welfare of its people, has ordained and established a Constitution and By-laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds it to be in the best interests of the Tribe and its members to maintain a membership in select national and regional organizations in order to facilitate better advocacy on certain issues; and select ITBC; and

**WHEREAS**, these various organizations require Tribal Council resolutions appointing the Official Tribal Representative.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Delaware Tribe of Indians that Dawn Sherman and Nicky K. Michael are duly authorized to represent the Delaware Tribe of Indians as delegate/representative to the InterTribal Buffalo Council; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Dawn Sherman is authorized to act/vote on behalf of the Delaware Tribe of Indians as required to ensure that the Tribe's interests and positions are represented; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Tristen Tucker shall be the alternate delegate and may act in absence of the delegate; and


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that dues payable to the InterTribal Buffalo Council shall be paid as they come due by the Tribal Treasurer until such time as this resolution is amended or rescinded; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that nothing in this resolution diminishes, divests, alters or otherwise affects any inherent, treaty, statutory, common law or other rights of the Delaware Tribe of Indians over any tribal land nor over the aforementioned activities conducted upon such land.


The Delaware Tribe of Indians expressly retains all rights and authority over said tribal land, including but not limited to legislative, regulatory, adjudicatory and taxing powers.
