

A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO SUBMIT AN EARLY HEAD START/CHILD CARE PARTNERSHIP GRANT IN 2014

RESOLUTION 2014-36

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians adopts this resolution to authorize the submission of an application to the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Head Start for an Early Head Start/Child Care Partnership Grant in 2014 for the implementation of Head Start/Child Care services through the Delaware Child Care programs; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe of Indians is eligible to apply for such grant thru the direct Federal relationship with the federal government and listing in the Federal Register of recognized tribal entities; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council presented the overview of the program for community review and comment at its regular meeting on September 15; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians has determined that it is in the best interest of the tribal community and hereby approves the submission of the Early Head Start/Child Care Partnership Grant; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby authorize and approve submission of an application and request for funding from the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Head Start for an Early Head Start/Child Care Partnership Grant for the implementation of Head Start/Child Care services through the Delaware Child Care programs.
