

A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE DELAWARE TRIBE OF INDIANS TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF THE TRIBAL SEAL BY NEW YORK'S DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

RESOLUTION 2016-37

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe Historic Preservation Office has partnered with the New York Department of Transportation (NY DOT) on a bridge project, and,

WHEREAS, the NY DOT will have a commemorative sign displayed about the bridge describing that partnership, and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe Tribal Seal Protection Ordinance, Section 3, Part 3.1 requires that use of the tribal seal shall be specifically authorized by resolution of the Tribal Council, and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council approves the use of the tribal seal for this commemorative sign;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby authorize and give the NY DOT permission to use the Delaware Tribe of Indians Tribal Seal for display on a commemorative sign.
